Passage: Matt 7:12-23

### Main points & Questions

Here are the main points summarized, with powerful questions for reflection:

#### 1. The Seriousness of Jesus' Words

- **Summary:** The Sermon on the Mount is direct and urgent, showing God's expectations of us. Jesus' words reflect not cruelty but love, similar to how a parent warns a child of danger.  
**Question:** How does viewing Jesus' words as loving warnings rather than harsh commands change how you respond to them?

#### 2. Rules as Protection, Not Restriction

- **Summary:** God's commands, like the illustration of the circular saw, are boundaries rooted in love. They guide and protect us, even when they feel uncomfortable.
- **Question:** Do you view God's commands as restrictive or as loving boundaries? How can this perspective shift your obedience?

#### 3. Hearing and Doing: The Firm Foundation

- **Summary:** Building your life on Jesus' words means both hearing and obeying. The parable of the two builders highlights the critical difference between outward religious activity and inward obedience.
- **Question:** Are you a hearer of Jesus' words or a doer? What practical step can you take to move from hearing to obeying?

#### 4. Sinking Sand vs. Solid Rock

- **Summary:** Cultural norms or personal desires may seem stable but collapse under pressure. Only Jesus' teachings provide the unshakable foundation needed to withstand both life's storms and God's final judgment.

**Question:** What foundation are you currently building your life on? Are there areas where you may be relying on “sinking sand” rather than Jesus?

## 5. Desperation for Grace

- **Summary:** Jesus’ teachings set a standard we can’t achieve on our own, driving us toward dependence on Him. Salvation isn’t earned by effort but received through surrender to Christ.

**Question:** How does recognizing your inability to meet God’s standards on your own deepen your dependence on Christ?

## 6. Jesus’ Authority Demands a Response

- **Summary:** Jesus taught with unparalleled authority, calling for obedience, not just admiration. To hear His words and not act on them is like ignoring a life-saving warning.

**Question:** What does it mean to you that Jesus speaks with authority? How does that affect your response to His teachings?

## 7. Good Discomfort

- **Summary:** God’s warnings, though uncomfortable, are gifts of grace to lead us toward life. Just as a harsh warning kept Emmett safe, God’s truths steer us away from danger and toward His protection.
- **Question:** When have you experienced “good discomfort” from God’s guidance? How did it protect or grow you?
